

- Do I have to stop to see an attendant?

YES!

- Why do I have to stop to see an attendant?

The Town of Grantham is fined for items that are not placed in the proper places, such as propane tanks, tires, and lithium batteries. The Attendants are able to use their expertise to determine where that material should go.

- Why do I recycle my cardboard, paper, aluminum, plastic, steel cans, and glass?

The Town of Grantham receives a credit from the disposal of these items and that credit is used to offset the cost of household trash. When residents do their part and recycle, it benefits the community by reducing costs and the amount of household trash.

- Why do I have to stop for brush?

There is a different disposal place for smaller size items and yard debris, size does matter with brush. The Attendants are able to use their expertise to determine where that material should go. Additionally, there has been a history of residents dropping carpets, pressure treated wood, and other items in with brush, our hope is to eliminate this issue.

- Why do I need to place my Transfer Station decal on the windshield in the lower right corner?

When residents come to the Transfer Station the Attendants can see the decal from the Main Shop and identify quickly that a person is a resident permitted to use the Transfer Station.

- Why are the Transfer Station Employees checking for valid stickers?

The Town of Grantham has found that a high number of non-residents try to access the Transfer Station to dispose of trash. The disposal of Trash is a significant cost, we want to ensure only Grantham based Taxpayers are accessing the Transfer Station.

- Why do the Rules and Regulations not have updated hours?

The Rules and Regulations is a document that must be voted on and signed by the Board of Selectmen and thus is not updated frequently. The Town is working on removing hours from this document to avoid future confusion.
