Board of Selectmen Meeting Minutes
June 15, 2021

The meeting of the Board of Selectmen was called to order at 4:11 PM on Tuesday, June 15, 2021, by Chairman Garland. The Board met in the Grantham Town Building, Jerry Whitney Memorial Meeting Room, 300 Route 10 South, Grantham, NH.

Present: Chairman Peter Garland; Selectman Constance Jones; Selectman Warren Kimball; Town Administrator Melissa White; and Transfer Station Supervisor Chris Scott

NEW BUSINESS

Transfer Station: Supervisor, Chris Scott stated that with the staff shortages and increased traffic, he is starting to feel overwhelmed with being able to get everything done. With only one other worker, it is impossible to get different tasks completed, like boxing up the electronics or refrigerators when the facility is open. Those types of tasks cannot be completely safely when the facility is open. Scott requested to be able to close on Monday, June 21, 2021, and one Monday per month if he needs to. In addition, Scott requested to reduce the hours on Fridays to 12 PM – 4 PM.

A motion was made by Selectman Kimball to allow Supervisor Chris Scott to close the Transfer Station on June 21, 2021, one Monday per month, and reduce the hours on Fridays to 12 PM – 4 PM, until further notice; seconded by Selectman Jones. Unanimously approved.


Scott informed that the used motor oil was picked up by Clean Harbors. He was happy to report that they (Clean Harbors) were amazed at how clean the oil was. Scott explained that it was due to restricting residents from dumping the oil themselves. Selectman Kimball stated that having a watchful eye over it has proved beneficial.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, Selectman Kimball moved to adjourn, seconded by Selectman Jones; by unanimous vote, the Board adjourned at 4:36 PM.
