The Town of Grantham is looking for volunteers to serve on the Master Plan Committee. The Grantham Master Plan Committee will oversee the development of an updated Master Plan for the Town.

## Why is the Master Plan Important?

Grantham's community development decisions affect the town's economy, environment, infrastructure, public facilities, historic resources, property values and taxes. The Grantham Master Plan serves as a blueprint for the town's future development that will guide local policy and decision-making.

## What are the Committee's Duties and Time Commitment?

The Master Plan Committee will work with staff at the Upper Valley Lake Sunapee Regional Planning Commission to complete a survey of town residents, outline a vision for the town's future development based on public feedback, and provide recommendations and technical guidance for Master Plan components. The Committee will meet monthly for approximately 18-24 months.
